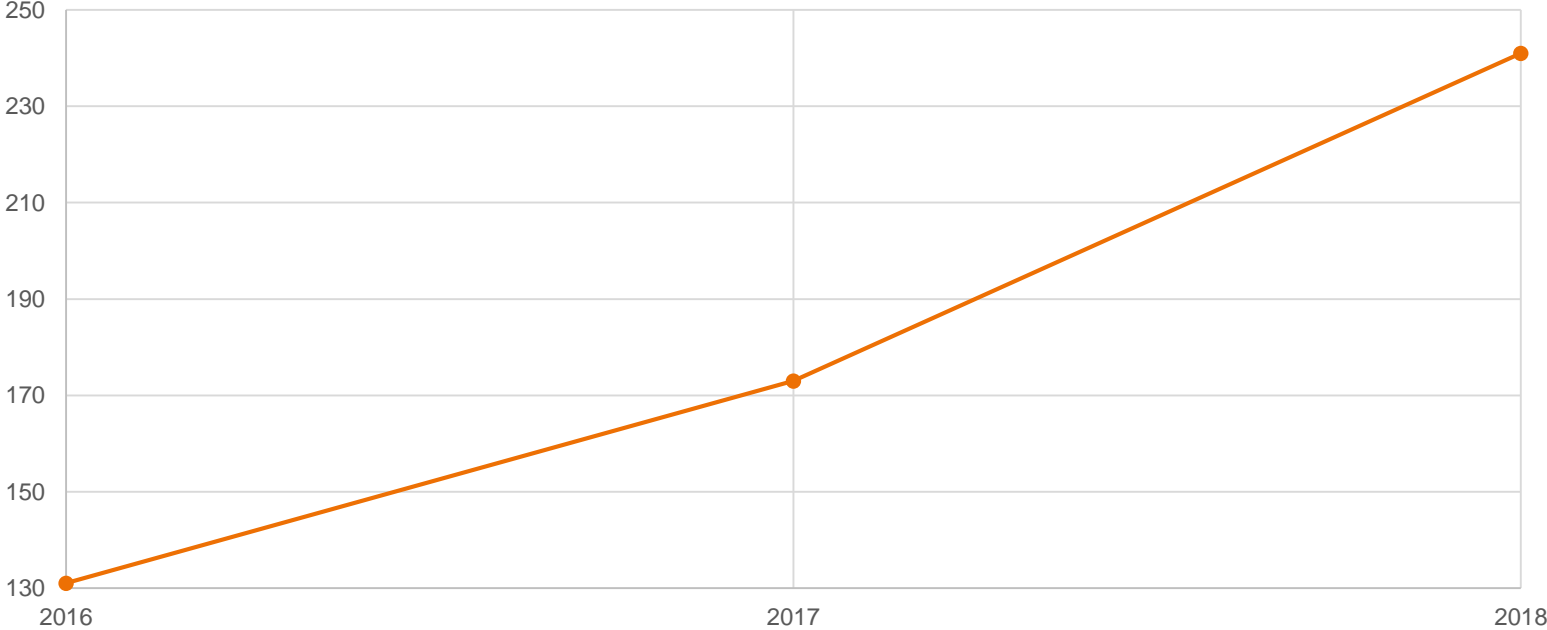
# Number of applications

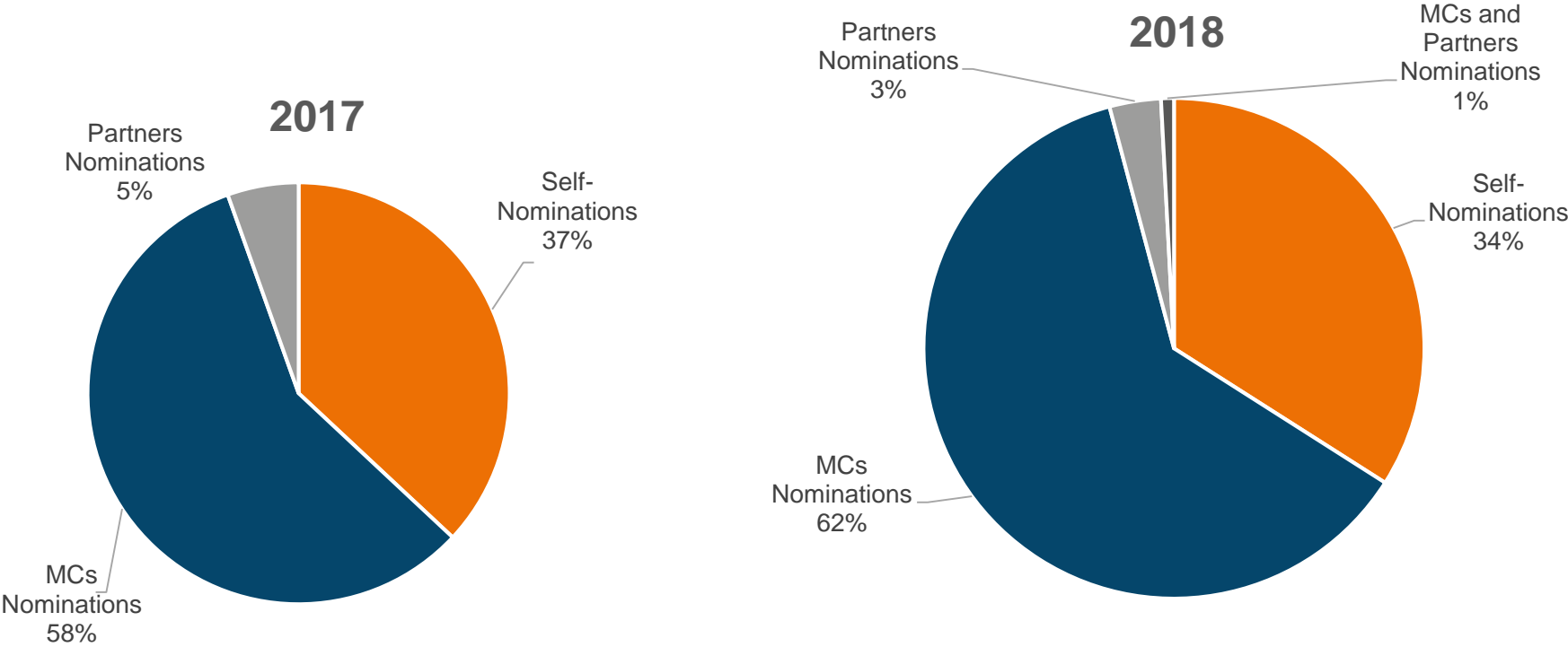

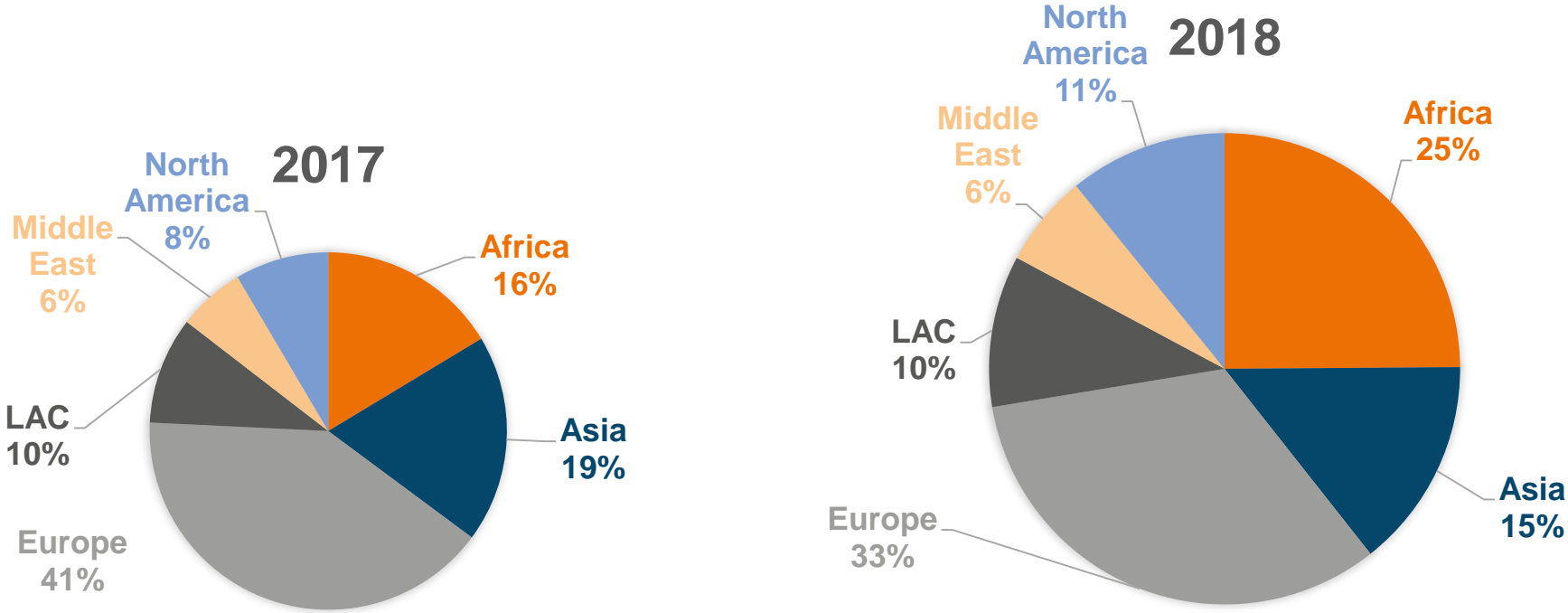
# MC Nominations

- Increase of the African percentage, decrease of the European and American ones. LAC and ME are stable.

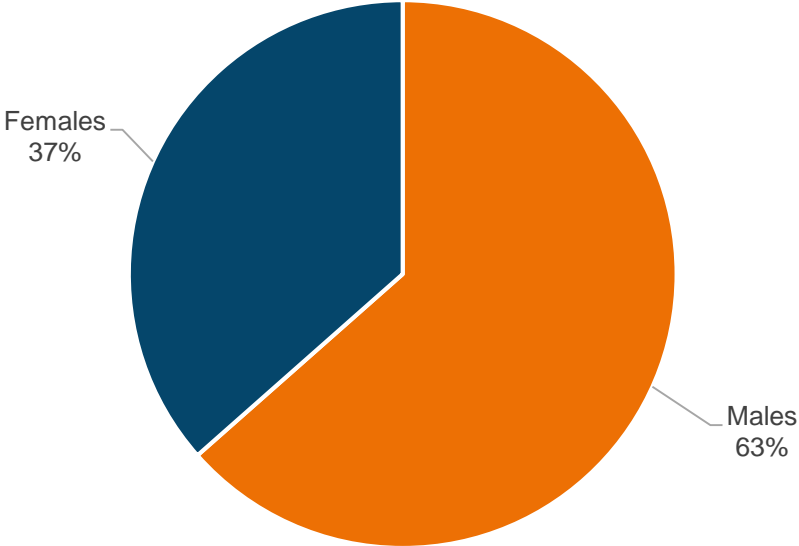


# Gender Count

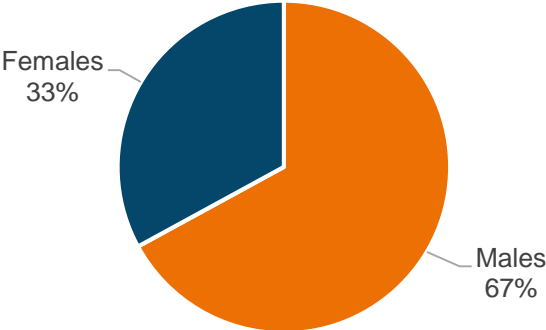
(complete applications only)

- General trend towards more female applicants

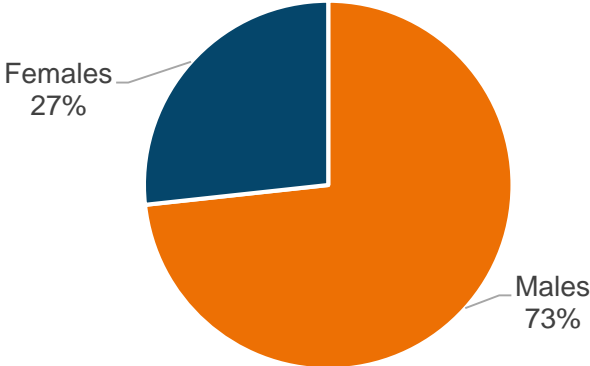
Male/ Female ratio in 2018



Male/ Female ratio in 2017



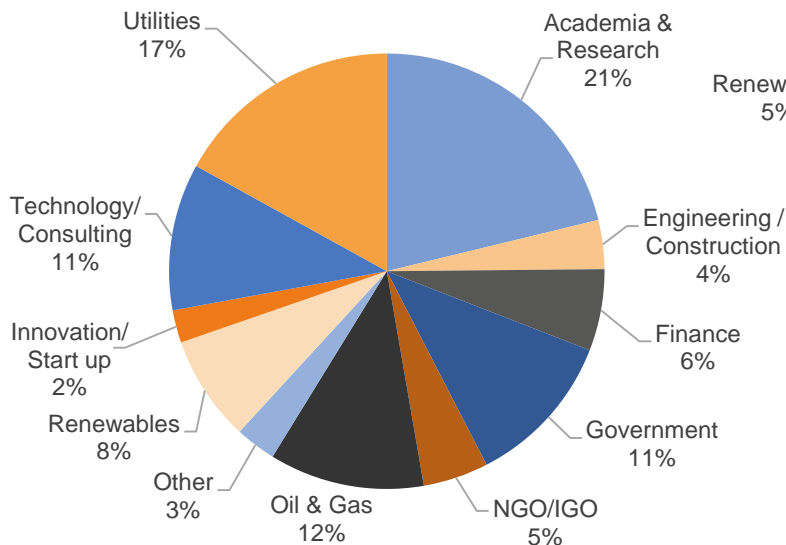
Male/ Female ratio in 2016



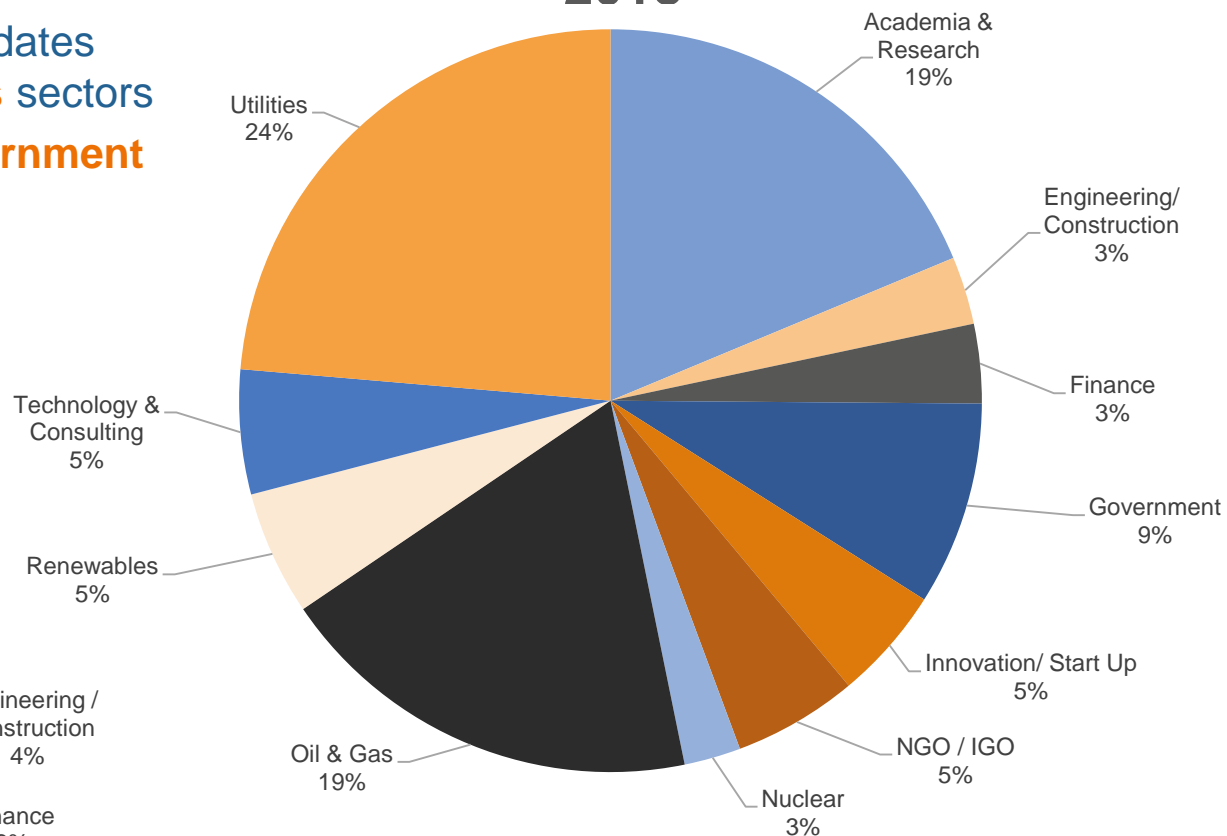
# Sector Representation
